
Chillicothe Holiday Parade

Public Speaking Mikaela Rojas and Kelsie Lorton competed





INCLEMENT WEATHER

Winter weather is right around the corner. The school will post school closings, late starts, and other school information on the Textcaster alert that can be signed up for on our school's homepage. If you are having issues or need help signing up, please let me know. I will be happy to help. Also, it will be broadcast on 99.1 KDWD and 96.9 KZBK radio stations. In the event of a weather related dismissal, the school will implement AMI instruction whenever possible. AMI is an Alternative Method of Instruction that is used when in-seat instruction cannot take place. We will use virtual learning in a modified schedule whenever bad weather days are predicted and we can prepare students with the tools needed for instruction. Preschool through First grades will have packets to complete, Second through Twelfth grades will have chromebooks for google meets, google classroom, etc. and will be expected to log on based on the modified schedule. When using an AMI day, we are considered in school and would not have to make up the day.

BOARD ELECTION

The Linn Co. R-I School District encourages qualified persons interested in running for a position on the School Board to file to be a candidate in the April 5th, 2022, election.

Interested persons may file at the superintendent's office. Filing will begin on Tuesday, December 7 2021, at 8:00 a.m. and will continue during the district's regular business hours, which are Tuesday through Friday from 7:45 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Except for the first and last day of filing, filing will not occur on days that the school district's central offices are closed due to inclement weather. Filing will also not occur on the following holidays and breaks when the school district's central offices are closed: December 22, 23, 24. and 27. Filing will end on Tuesday, December 28 2021, at 5:00 p.m There are two positions available with three-year terms currently held by Daniel Singleton and Shannon Murrell.

Christmas Concerts

The Junior High/High School concert will be held on December 9th at 7:00 p.m. and

the Elementary concert is scheduled for December 16 th at 7:00 p.m. The visitors side bleachers will be used for the students that are involved in the concert to sit in. Chairs will be set up on the gym floor for guests and the home side bleachers will be available for guest seating also.

During the elementary concert, the Preschool will perform first. Once they are finished, parents will get their Preschool students and have them sit with them for the remainder of the concert. The other grade levels will perform in order after preschool. We will be having the Elementary raffle this year, so please stay and wait for names to be drawn at the end of the concert. After the drawing you can pick your student(s) up from the visiting side bleachers.

The concerts will be livestreamed on the Linn County R-I Facebook page. This is subject to change according to local health department guidelines/CDC guidelines.

Second Quarter/First Semester

The second quarter/first semester will end on December 21st. We will dismiss at noon that day for Christmas break. The students will return to school on Tuesday, January 4 th . ACADEMIC OPTIONS

Second Semester Spring 2022 We have found that most families want their children to continue in person learning, but some prefer an online option because of the COVID-19 pandemic. If you have questions or need help, call us at 660-244-5035. You must sign up for the online option by FRIDAY, DECEMBER 10TH to allow us time to plan for class enrollments. Please call the school by Friday, December 10th if you would like your student(s) to be considered for the online option. If we do not hear from you by Dec. 10, we will plan for your child to attend school in person.

Online Learning:

Students who choose not to return in person will use our Linn Co. Online option. This is an online-only option we offer for students from across the Linn Co. R-1 School District. It will include an online educational platform from out of District educators. These students will not be on campus during the school day for activities like celebrations or participation in athletic events.

- Students will be considered full time Linn County R-1 students
- Parents and students will communicate with Educere educators
- Students will not be permitted to participate in extracurricular activities
- Students will be committed to online learning for an entire semester
- (January May)

Kindergarten and First Grade Field Trip




