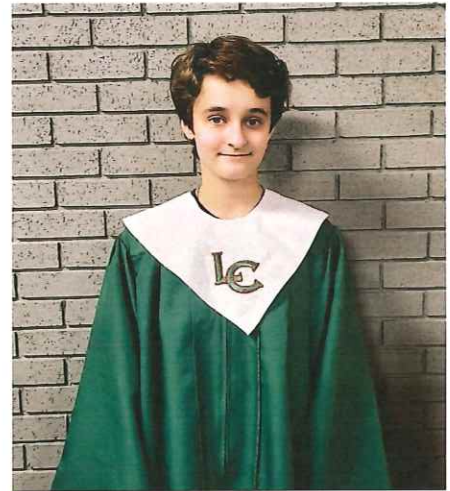
FFA Area III Public Speaking

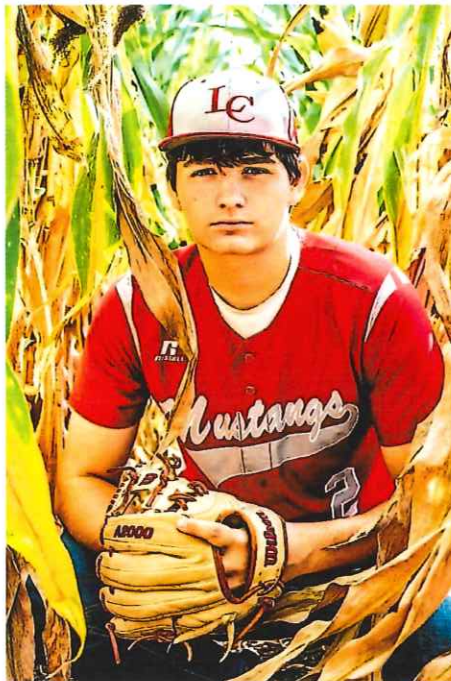

ACADEMIC OPTIONS

Second Semester Spring 2023

We have found that most families want their children to continue in person learning, but some prefer an online option because of the COVID-19 pandemic. If you have questions or need help, call us at 660-244-5035.

You must sign up for the online option by **FRIDAY, DECEMBER 16TH** to allow us time to plan for class enrollments. **Please call the school by Friday, December 16th if you would like your student(s) to be considered for the online option.** If we do not hear from you by December 16th, we will plan for your child to attend school in person.

Online Learning:

Students who choose not to return in person will use our Linn County Online option. This is an online-only option we are offering for students from across the Linn County R-1 School District. It will include an online educational platform provided by out of District educators. These students will not be on campus during the school day for activities like celebrations or participation in athletic events.

- Students will be considered full time Linn County R-1 students
- Parents and students will communicate with Educere educators
- Students will not be permitted to participate in extra-curricular activities
- Students will be committed to online learning for an entire semester (January - May)

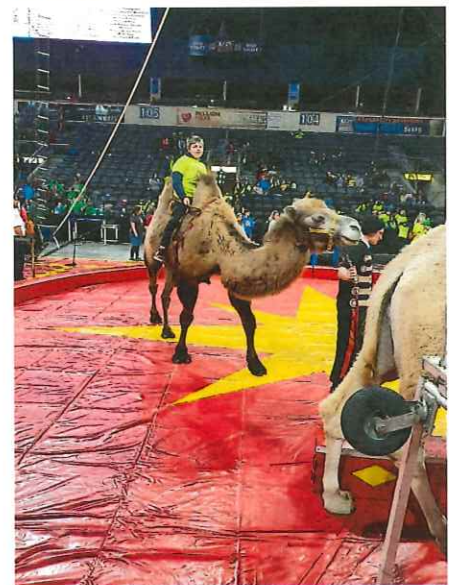

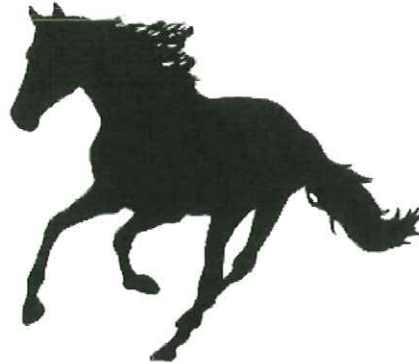
