LOOKING FOR 3 AND 4 YEAR OLD CHILDREN ELIGIBLE FOR PRESCHOOL AND 5 YEAR OLD CHILDREN ELIGIBLE FOR KINDERGARTEN.

Linn County Preschool will enroll a maximum of 15 students. The first spots will be filled with FULL TIME 4 & 5 year olds.

Waiting list will be determined by the DIAL-4 test given at the preschool screenings:

- 1) Full-Time 3 year olds*
- 2) Part-Time 4 & 5 year olds*
- 3) Part-Time 3 year olds*
