BOARD ELECTION

The Linn Co. R-I School District encourages qualified persons interested in running for a position on the School Board to file to be a candidate in the April 3, 2018, election. Interested persons may file at the superintendent's office. Filing will begin on December 12, 2017, at 8:00 a.m. and will continue during the district's regular business hours, which are Monday through Friday from 7:45 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Except for the first and last day of filing, filing will not occur on days that the school district's central offices are closed due to inclement weather. Filing will also not occur on the following holidays and breaks when the school district's central offices are closed: December 20 – January 2 and January 15. Filing will end on January 16, 2018, at 5:00 p.m. There are two positions available with three-year terms currently held by Janis Guyer and Amy Johnson.

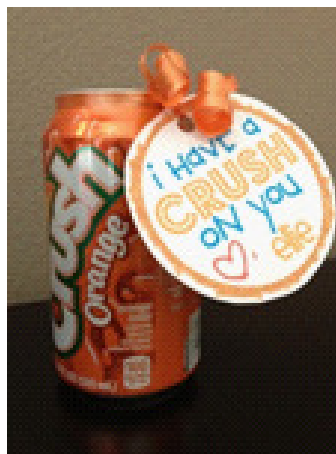
