Linn County Preschool will enroll a maximum of 15 students.

Enrollment is first come first served for full-time 4 & 5 year olds.

Waiting list will be determined by:

- 1. Full-Time 3 Year-Olds
- 2. Part-Time 4 & 5 Year-Olds
 - 3. Part-Time 3 Year-Olds
 - 4. Out of District Children

CRITERIA

3 YEARS OLD BEFORE AUGUST 1, 2025 (preschool) 5 YEARS OLD BEFORE AUGUST 1, 2025 (kindergarten)

PRESCHOOL PROGRAM FOLLOWS THE LINN COUNTY R-1 2025-2026 CALENDAR - 4 DAY SCHOOL WEEK-TUESDAY-FRIDAY

ELIGIBLE TO RIDE THE BUS UPON 4TH BIRTHDAY

PRESCHOOL MAY ATTEND 2-4 DAYS PER WEEK; KINDERGARTEN 4 DAYS PER WEEK

PARENTS/GUARDIANS OF PRESCHOOL STUDENTS WILL SIGN AN ENROLLMENT FORM AND AGREEMENT

STATING THE DAYS YOUR CHILD WILL ATTEND

THERE IS A REQUIRED FLAT FEE PER WEEK BASED ON THE AGREEMENT FORM FOR PRESCHOOL
